Addendum to Re-opening Plan Submitted to NYS in August 2020

Updated for Pre-K 4 only

Based on parent preference, students in Pre-K 4 will be instructed either in person or remotely 5 days a week. The change being respectfully requested is to add two students to the existing class of 15 in person students.

If approved, the following changes will be made:

1. A new large table will be added to the Pre-K 4 classroom to ensure that there are three feet of distance between each of the 17 children.
2. The two students whose parents are requesting that they move from remote to in person learning will be assigned to that new table.
3. The Pre-K 4 class will be divided into cohorts of 9 (Cohort 1) and 8 (Cohort 2) for lunch, using the adjoining classroom for the cohort of 8.
4. The 11:00-11:30 A.M. Pre-K 4 lunch period for Cohort 2 to a school aide. The school aide who normally monitors the Pre-K 4 lunch period will continue monitoring lunch in the Pre-K 4 classroom for Cohort 1. The teacher will maintain her regular lunch period.
5. Cohort 2 will join Cohort 1 in the Pre-K 4 classroom for naptime where there is room for students to nap head-to-toe and toe-to head, maintaining six feet between each child's head.
6. All students will continue to use their own set of materials which are sanitized on a regular basis.
7. Face masks will continue to be required to be worn by all students and adults in the school building. Masks must be worn appropriately, covering both the nose and the mouth.
